NORTHERN CALIFORNIA CORVETTE ASSOCIATION GENERAL MEETING - JANUARY 9, 1973

The regular business meeting of the Northern California Corvette Association at General Motors Training Center in San Leandro was called to order by President Mike Irish at 8:15 P.M. with 18 members and 8 guests present.

Mike asked each guest to introduce themselves. The guests present were: Steve and Carol Horton, Leigh Corbin, Bob Stephano, Ken West, Mike Halloran, Lewis Larimer and Jim Saxton.

Secretary Lynne Irish reported that she hadn't received the December 5th meeting minutes from last year's Secretary LaVonne Pygeorge, so we will read it at the February 6th meeting.

Treasurers Report - Treasurer Samantha O'Brien read the Balance of the Treasury as of December 18, 1972 when the account was transferred to Wells Fargo Bank. She then read the Balance as of January 9, 1973 and that we still have two outstanding bills.

Activities Report - Our Vice President, Jerry Olson was in Chicago on business, so Mike Irish gave the activities report. February 3rd we are putting on a "LIMIT 100", practice Autocross at the fairgrounds in Pleasanton. Mike mentioned that we need all the workers we can get as this will be a tune-up for our Championship Autocross later in the year. Clark Nelson mentioned that we should get the information out to the newspapers by this coming weekend if we wanted to advertise the Autocross. A discussion followed.

Mike stated that we should keep in mind that our W.S.C.C. sanctioned Concour will be held in the early part of April. Concour Chairman, Jerry Lockwood said that details will be forthcoming. Samantha O'Brien announced she has registration forms for the annual easy chair "St. Valentines Day Massacre". She stated that this is a Rallye on paper which takes 5 weeks to finish.

Mike read off the NCSCC Autocrosses that were on the calendar for the first half of the year. He mentioned the WSCC meeting would be January 20th at the Fresno Hilton starting at 1:00 P.M. plus on the same day the NCSCC Awards Banquet at Ricky's Hyatt House in Palo Alto - Cocktails at 6:00 and Dinner at 7:00 P.M. and that the regular meeting of NCSCC would be January 26th in Redwood City at Mel's Bowl starting at 8:00 P.M..

Membership Report - Rudy Pretti, Membership Director stated that there were no new members to be brought in this month.

Social Report - Nancy Lockwood, Social Director stated that on January 27th we will have a Trailer Clean-up Party at the Pygeorges. Wear your grubbles and lunch arrangements are being made. She stated that in February that Corvettes of Nappa Valley were setting up a Winery Tour and Bar-B-Q. WSCC Report - Milt Piver discussed the re-opening of Sears Point Raceway and the negotiations of it's use for WSCC member clubs.

Milt then gave a report on the WSCC Convention being held in Tucson, Arizona May 24 thru 28. Mike Irish stated that NCCA would again submit for the Third time, a bid to print the WSCC Bylaws, Constitution, Guidelines and Competition Codes booklet. Milt Piver mentioned that NCCA was the only club to submit a bid in writing.

NCSCC Report - Mike Irish stated that the Autocross Committee had sent an idea back to be discussed by the member clubs. It envolves throwing out 1 event for every 3 Championship Autocrosses run. Discussion followed. [Continued]




